### ***Digital Painting-Assignment Due: 2 weeks from posting***

1) Using photoshop images that are found from personal photographs, (or photos from other classes or specifically taken for this assignment) create a digital artpiece arising from a concept. This concept can originate from a book title, a poem, a nursery rhyme, an ad..... or something of your own devising.

Create a digital artpiece. All bitmap images that you use must be free of copyright infringement and must not be resulting from a search using "GOOGLE IMAGES." At the beginning of each class will be a critique of your progress, so a jpeg must of your work must be created prior to critique that we may upload to the smart board for all the class to see,

Beginning with a drawing, YOU MUST use this image which you can "live trace." This should be used as a basis for your background or as a pattern or some other element in your final piece.

But a pattern (of some kind) MUST be incorporated into your composition. It can be used as an overlay, a border, or as some other element in your overall work (we used it as background, a tattoo, and as an overlay in the examples that were shown in class.)

All drawings and materials used as inspiration must remain in their original format in hidden layers within your photoshop or illustrator document. DO NOT FLATTEN ANY OF YOUR WORK.

If you use photoshop as your basis application for your project, you MUST use an illustrator image ( or document) as a placed "SMART OBJECT " within your final composition.

If you use illustrator as your basis application for this project, you MUST place a photoshop image into the final document and use a "CLIPPING MASK " within the final composition.

The finals will be mounted on matte boards .  
All boards must be trimmed with one inch borders.

8) You must also turn in the "native" layered file (Photoshop or Illustrator) on a DISK (not your flash drive, removable drive, or any other format than a burned disk) and must be turned in at the beginning of class on the due date.

Make sure that if you are creating the piece in Illustrator that all of your LINKED images are included on your disk within the folder or it will count against you.
