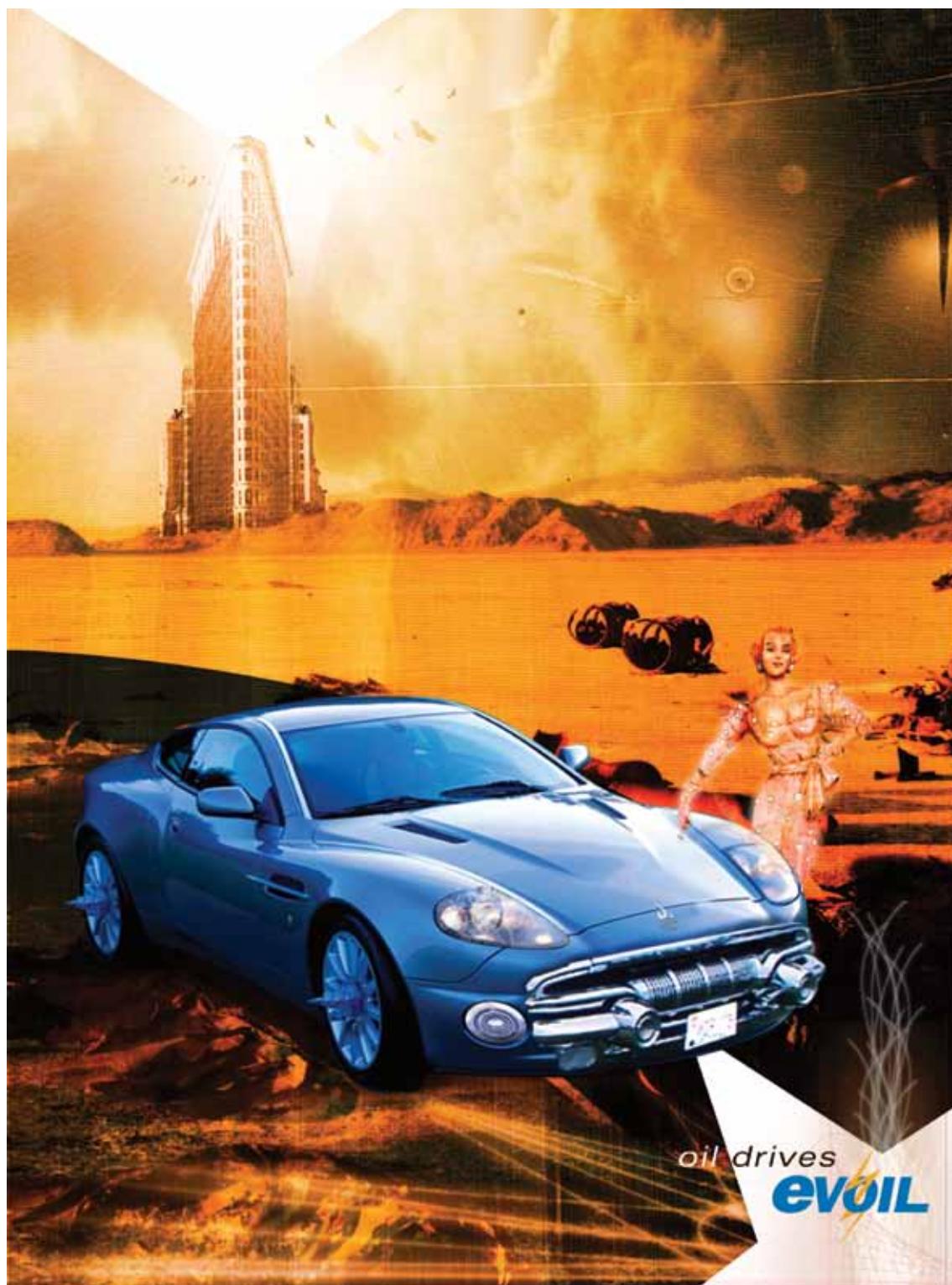

Start with a concept. . . an idea. . . a word

never begin a project without one.

Your Project MUST contain elements outlined below. Original formats are to be included and mounted on matte board with one inch borders plus the printed photoshop doc.

Photoshop piece will be on mounted on a separate matte board. Size no smaller than 11" X 17".

Prints should be output using only FSC certified or GreenSeal Certified paper. . . (proof of paper will be required.) You will be required to print the last day of the week prior to the final test in class.

The Layered Photoshop file will also be turned in on CD/DVD.

Inside the layered file there will be evidence of:

- An original drawing
- Original photography

Layers must have these elements:

1. a pattern which is "multiplied" in a layer
2. an object which uses "overlay" in a layer
3. a layer which contains a mask
4. a layer that applies a filter
5. a layer which uses a sky photo
6. a layer which uses a ground photo
7. a layer which uses an architectural object that you manipulate into a new form
(this can be a found object but it must be manipulated so as not to look like the original form)

- must contain objects created in Illustrator
- AND placed into your document as smart objects.

Those objects must be:

1. a mesh object
2. a blend
3. a pattern

- Finally: A Typographical entity; ie Title, logo, phrase created in illustrator and placed as a smart object.
